Educational Point Allowance: Forms for claiming educational point allowance will be provided to registered conference attendees in their registration packet. Registration packets will provided at the event.

UPPCC Total Hours: 1 recertification point for every 8 educational contact hours at NIGP Chapter Conferences/Symposiums. This may include 6 hours of educational programs and 2 hours of products exposition time, for a maximum of 2 points per chapter conference/symposium.

VCO / VCA Total Hours: 1 recertification point for every 6 educational contact hours, 2 hours are allowed for products exposition time. Up to 2 points per conferences/symposiums sponsored by a national, state or local public or private purchasing organization.
